Controversial Moore River South Land Sale

Friends of Moore River Estuary seek a buyer for the contested area south of the river to preclude a development taking place.

After more than twenty years of highly controversial efforts to get an unpopular development underway, the Moore River Company has put the entire 2099 hectare holding on the market.

"This heralds another zig in the zag of the Moore River Estuary's narrative," said FOMRE spokesperson, Linda Johnson.

"What our community organisation is looking for is a philanthropic buyer who would guarantee to offer the land to the state, so that all of us now, and our descendants into the future, could enjoy a <u>regional park</u>, instead of the river, its estuary and surrounding bushland being spoiled by yet another coastal development," she continued.

"The search is on for a generous community minded individual or group, to ensure that a King's Park of the north, at the outer boundary of the metropolitan area, is created.

"This is a rare opportunity, not to be squandered," Linda Johnson concluded.
