GABBADAH PARK BARBECUE

A sparkling new barbecue has been installed in Gabbadah Park and the old structure removed.

The barbecue was originally installed with a limestone surround, designed and built by the community with donated limestone and volunteer labour. The outer stones were carved with various fish and animals commemorating the year 2000.

In restoring the barbecue, the shire has retained some of the carved stones that were in reasonable condition and secured them to the surrounding retaining wall. The result is a pleasing and tasteful arrangement of the stones, together with the commemorative plaque installed in 2001.
